What is KMCHP?

Kern Medical Center Health Plan (KMCHP) is a county funded program that provides care to eligible Kern County residents. It's a way for those people who meet certain requirements to get quality, ongoing medical care at **little to no cost**. KMCHP works with you to determine eligibility, assist with the application process and provide continuing coverage for those who qualify.

What is Included?

All enrollees of KMCHP will qualify to receive the following medical benefits:

- ✓ Outpatient Services - Primary Care
- ✓ Prescription & Limited Non-Prescription Medications
- ✓ Physical Therapy
- ✓ Medical Equipment & Supplies
- ✓ Radiology
- ✓ Acute Inpatient Hospital Services
- ✓ Laboratory Services
- ✓ Physician Services (including Specialty Care & Podiatry)
- ✓ Prior-Authorized, Non-Emergency Medical Transportation
- ✓ Prosthetic & Orthotic Appliances & Devices
- ✓ Emergency Care Services (at KMC only)

Some enrollees of KMCHP may also qualify to receive:

- ✓ Out-of-Network Emergency Care Services
- ✓ Emergency Transportation Services
- ✓ Mental Health Services

In addition to medical benefits, enrollees of KMCHP will also receive:

- ✓ Health Education Materials
- ✓ Member Handbook
- ✓ Toll Free Member Services Line
- ✓ Provider Directory
- ✓ Free Newsletter Subscription
- ✓ Member ID Card

Who is Eligible?

In order to qualify for KMCHP benefits, the following eligibility requirements must be met:

- Adults between the ages of 19-64
- Income at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level
 - *Applicants with income exceeding 100% of the Federal Poverty Level and who meet all other eligibility requirements may still qualify, but will be responsible for a Share of Cost determined by household income.
- Resident of Kern County for 30 days
- Not enrolled or eligible for other state health plans such as Medi-Cal or CHIP
- US Citizen or a legal resident of the United States for 5 or more years
