Kern County Cooling Centers

This year the Kern County Cooling Center season will begin on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 and end on the first day of autumn, Friday, September 21, 2018 .

For the health, safety, and comfort of our residents, Kern County General Services, in cooperation with the Department of Aging and Adult Services, other Kern County agencies and/or districts, and PG&E, will open Cooling Centers throughout the County when temperatures are **forecast by the National Weather Service (NWS)** to exceed certain highs. Cooling Centers open in the San Joaquin and Kern River Valleys when the temperatures are **forecast** to be **105** degrees or higher, in the desert areas when temperatures are **forecast** to be **108** degrees or higher, and in Frazier Park when temperatures are **forecast** to be **95** degrees or higher. The centers will be open from 1:00-8:00 p.m.
